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INTERNATIONAL CANNABIS CULTIVATION QUESTIONNAIRE (ICCQ)

Purpose: To measure patterns of small scale cannabis cultivation.

Description: The ICCQ is an 35-item measurement that is designed to

measure patterns of small scale cannabis cultivation. The questionnaire includes items on experiences with growing cannabis, methods and scale of growing operations, reasons for growing, the participant's personal use of cannabis and other drugs, participation in cannabis and other drug markets, police contacts and participant's involvement in other non-drug related illegal activities and demographic characteristics. The ICCQ also includes items to test eligibility and recruitment source, and a set of items that should be included in pages on participant

information and informed consent.

GUIDELINES

The ICCQ questionnaire is currently being used by a group of researchers interested in better understanding patterns of cannabis cultivation. This group of researchers created a network – the *Global Cannabis Cultivation Research Consortium* (GCCRC) - and developed the ICCQ as a core online questionnaire for an international audience of cannabis growers. This group of researchers is currently running on-line surveys on patterns of cannabis cultivation in their individual countries (Australia, the US, Canada, the UK, Belgium, Denmark, Finland and the Netherlands). Each country survey is funded locally or nationally. In most of these countries the ICCQ was used as a core model questionnaire and country-specific items were added.

Researchers who would like to join this international comparative study are welcome to contact one of the participating teams (for a list, see at the end of this document), and may use the ICCQ as a basis for their own study, on the condition that they cite the ICCQ as indicated on the previous page and mention the GCCRC network. Participating countries can add extra items according to their preferences and the focus of their own studies.

The first three questions (A, B and C) are mandatory questions and are designed to determine the eligibility of participants for the study. The numbered questions (1 to 35) are optional, in the sense that participants can skip questions or chose options such as 'I don't know' or 'I don't want to answer this question'.

Most questions allow participants to select only one answer; when participants are allowed to select more than one answer (multiple response set), this is mentioned explicitly ("Check all that apply").

The questionnaire contains grey text boxes with some explanatory information for participants. Individual countries can add extra information in these preambles, or rephrase the wording if this is considered to be more appropriate given the national circumstances.

Several questions allow individual countries to add extra categories to meet country-specific circumstances.

- Inclusion criteria: participants must have grown cannabis at least once, they must be living in the host country and they must be at least 18 years of age.
- Mention what participation in the study involves: an online questionnaire, provide a summary of topics covered (ensure these actually match with the items of the ICCQ, including country-specific variations and additional items!).
- The questionnaire contains 35 questions, but participants probably won't have to answer all of these. It usually takes about 15 minutes to complete the ICCQ.

- Participation is voluntary. Participants can withdraw consent at any time, consent will be assumed upon submission of data.
- Mention that information is strictly confidential, that no identifying information will be collected, that no IP addresses will be logged, and that for added protection participants are welcome to use an anonymiser (e.g. Tor). Also mention how long data will be stored securely at host university.
- Mention that results will be presented at conferences and in academic papers. Data will only be presented in aggregate form. Identifying information of individuals and groups will be removed to maintain anonymity.
- Add contact information for study representative.
- Add formula "By clicking 'begin survey', I confirm that..." in informed consent page
- Ask participants to complete questionnaire only once, and to answer each question carefully and honestly.
